Future Pipe delivered a total of 34k' of a mixture of 3", 4", 6" and 8", 2250 psi Yellow Box® Line pipe. The lines carry produced water and hydrocarbons with temperatures ranging from 20° to 140° F (-7° to 60°C).

Our field service technicians installed all the 6" and 8" lines using power tongs. The 3" and 4" were installed by the contractor using strap wrenches following extensive training from Future Pipe and under FPI's supervision. All lines were installed effectively and efficiently as well as being tested to be leak free when running to full design pressure.
